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What is the PrescribaRx Formulary?

A formulary is a list of covered drugs selected by PrescribaRx in consultation with a team of health care providers, which represents the prescription therapies believed to be a necessary part of a quality treatment program. PrescribaRx will generally cover the drugs listed in our formulary as long as the drug is medically necessary, the prescription is filled at a PrescribaRx network pharmacy, and other plan rules are followed. For more information on how to fill your prescriptions, please review your Evidence of Coverage.

This document is a partial formulary and includes only some of the drugs covered by PrescribaRx. For a complete listing of all prescription drugs covered by PrescribaRx, please visit our Web site at www.PrescribaRx.com or call 1-800-818-0007, 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. in your local time zone (TTY users call 1-800-777-9083) every day.

Can the Formulary change?

Generally, if you are taking a drug on our 2010 formulary that was covered at the beginning of the year, we will not discontinue or reduce coverage of the drug during the 2010 coverage year except when a new, less expensive generic drug becomes available or when new adverse information about the safety or effectiveness of a drug is released. Other types of formulary changes, such as removing a drug from our formulary, will not affect members who are currently taking the drug. It will remain available at the same cost-sharing for those members taking it for the remainder of the coverage year. We feel it is important that you have continued access for the remainder of the coverage year to the formulary drugs that were available when you chose our plan, except for cases in which you can save additional money or we can ensure your safety.

If we remove drugs from our formulary, add prior authorization, quantity limits and/or step therapy restrictions on a drug or move a drug to a higher cost-sharing tier, we must notify affected members of the change at least 60 days before the change becomes effective, or at the time the member requests a refill of the drug, at which time the member will receive a 60-day supply of the drug. If the Food and Drug Administration deems a drug on our formulary to be unsafe or the drug's manufacturer removes the drug from the market, we will immediately remove the drug from our formulary and provide notice to members who take the drug. The enclosed formulary is current as of September 1, 2009. How do I use the Formulary?

There are two ways to find your drug within the formulary:

Medical Condition

The formulary begins on page 10. The drugs in this formulary are grouped into categories depending on the type of medical conditions that they are used to treat. For example, drugs used to treat a heart condition are listed under the category, “Cardiovascular Agents.” If you know what your drug is used for, look for the category name in the list that begins on page 8. Then look under the category name for your drug.

Alphabetical Listing

If you are not sure what category to look under, you should look for your drug in the Index that begins on page 28. The Index provides an alphabetical list of all of the drugs included in this document. Both brand name drugs and generic drugs are listed in the Index. Look in the Index and find your drug. Next to your drug, you will see the page number where you can find coverage information. Turn to the page listed in the Index and find the name of your drug in the first column of the list.

What are generic drugs?

PrescribaRx covers both brand name drugs and generic drugs. A generic drug is approved by the FDA as having the same active ingredient as the brand name drug. Generally, generic drugs cost less than brand name drugs.

Are there any restrictions on my coverage?

Some covered drugs may have additional requirements or limits on coverage. These requirements and limits may include:

- **Prior Authorization:** PrescribaRx requires you [or your physician] to get prior authorization for certain drugs. This means that you will need to get approval from PrescribaRx before you fill your prescriptions. If you don't get approval, PrescribaRx may not cover the drug.
- **Quantity Limits:** For certain drugs, PrescribaRx limits the amount of the drug that PrescribaRx will cover. For example, PrescribaRx provides 30 tablets per prescription for *simvastatin*. This may be in addition to a standard one month or three month supply.
- **Step Therapy:** In some cases, PrescribaRx requires you to first try certain drugs to treat your medical condition before we will cover another drug for that condition. For example, if Drug A and Drug B both treat your medical condition, PrescribaRx may not cover Drug B unless you try Drug A first. If Drug A does not work for you, PrescribaRx will then cover Drug B.

You can find out if your drug has any additional requirements or limits by looking in the formulary that begins on page 10. You can also get more information about the restrictions applied to specific covered drugs by visiting our Web site at www.PrescribaRx.com.

You can ask PrescribaRx to make an exception to these restrictions or limits. See the section, “How do I request an exception to the PrescribaRx formulary?” on page 3 for information about how to request an exception.

What if my drug is not on the Formulary?

If your drug is not included in this list of covered drugs, you should first contact Customer Service and ask if your drug is covered. This document includes only a partial list of covered drugs, so PrescribaRx may cover your drug. You can contact Customer Service at 1-800-818-0007, 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. in your local time zone (TTY users call 1-800-777-9083) every day.

If you learn that PrescribaRx does not cover your drug, you have two options:

- You can ask Customer Service for a list of similar drugs that are covered by PrescribaRx. When you receive the list, show it to your doctor and ask him or her to prescribe a similar drug that is covered by PrescribaRx.
- You can ask PrescribaRx to make an exception and cover your drug. See below for information about how to request an exception.

How do I request an exception to the PrescribaRx Formulary?

You can ask PrescribaRx to make an exception to our coverage rules. There are several types of exceptions that you can ask us to make.

- You can ask us to cover your drug even if it is not on our formulary.
- You can ask us to waive coverage restrictions or limits on your drug. For example, for certain drugs, PrescribaRx limits the amount of the drug that we will cover. If your drug has a quantity limit, you can ask us to waive the limit and cover more.

Generally, PrescribaRx will only approve your request for an exception if the alternative drugs included on the plan’s formulary, or additional utilization restrictions would not be as effective in treating your condition and/or would cause you to have adverse medical effects.

You should contact us to ask us for an initial coverage decision for a formulary or utilization restriction exception. **When you are requesting a formulary or utilization restriction exception you should submit a statement from your physician supporting your request.** Generally, we must make our decision within 72 hours of getting your prescribing physician’s supporting statement. You can request an expedited (fast) exception if you or your doctor believe that your health could be seriously harmed by waiting up to 72 hours for a decision. If your request to expedite is granted, we must give you a decision no later than 24 hours after we get your prescribing physician’s supporting statement.

What do I do before I can talk to my doctor about changing my drugs or requesting an exception?

As a new or continuing member in our plan you may be taking drugs that are not on our formulary. Or, you may be taking a drug that is on our formulary but your ability to get it is limited. For example, you may need a prior authorization from us before you can fill your prescription. You should talk to your doctor to decide if you should switch to an appropriate drug that we cover or request a formulary exception so that we will cover the drug you take. While you talk to your doctor to determine the right course of action for you, we may cover your drug in certain cases during the first 90 days you are a member of our plan.

For each of your drugs that is not on our formulary or if your ability to get your drugs is limited, we will cover a temporary 30-day supply (unless you have a prescription written for fewer days) when you go to a network pharmacy. After your first 30-day supply, we will not pay for these drugs, even if you have been a member of the plan less than 90 days.

If you are a resident of a long-term care facility, we will cover a temporary 34-day transition supply (unless you have a prescription written for fewer days). We will cover more than one refill of these drugs for the first 90 days you are a member of our plan. If you need a drug that is not on our formulary or if your ability to get your drugs is limited, but you are past the first 90 days of membership in our plan, we will cover a 34-day emergency supply of that drug (unless you have a prescription for fewer days) while you pursue a formulary exception.

If you are a current member in our plan, we will also cover a temporary transition supply if you have a change in your medications because of a level-of-care change. This may include unplanned changes in treatment settings, such as being discharged from an acute care (hospital) setting or being admitted to, or discharged from, a long-term care facility. For each drug that is not in our formulary, or if your ability to get your drugs is limited, we will cover a temporary 30-day supply (up to a 34-day supply if you are a resident of a long-term care facility) when you go to a network pharmacy.

The abridged formulary below provides coverage information about some of the drugs covered by PrescribaRx. If you have trouble finding your drug in the list, turn to the Index that begins on page 28. Remember: This is only a partial list of drugs covered by PrescribaRx. If your prescription is not in this partial formulary, please visit our Web site at www.PrescribaRx.com or call Customer Service at 1-800-818-0007, 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. in your local time zone (TTY users call 1-800-777-9083) every day for additional help.

The first column of the chart lists the drug name. Brand name drugs are capitalized (e.g., AMOXIL) and generic drugs are listed in lower-case italics (e.g., *amoxicillin*).

The information in the Notes column tells you if PrescribaRx has any special requirements for coverage of your drug.

- Prior Authorization drugs are designated with the abbreviation 'PA'.
- Quantity Limit drugs are designated with the abbreviation 'QL'.
- Step Therapy drugs are designated with the abbreviation 'ST'.
- Limited Access drugs are designated with the abbreviation 'LA'. This prescription may be available only at certain pharmacies. Tier Indications

The amount you pay for your prescriptions depends on the medication's tier. The PrescribaRx Signature formulary has 3 tiers.

Generic Tier 'G'

The Generic tier is your lowest-cost tier. Generic drugs contain the same active ingredients as brand-name drugs and are equally safe and effective. Not all generic drugs on the formulary are included in this tier. To help you save the most, we have also included some brands in this tier.

Brand Tier 'B'

This is your middle-cost tier, and includes brand drugs and some generic drugs.

Specialty Tier 'SP'

The Specialty tier is your highest-cost tier. A Specialty tier drug is a very high cost or unique prescription drug which may require special handling and/or close monitoring. Specialty drugs may be brand or generic.
